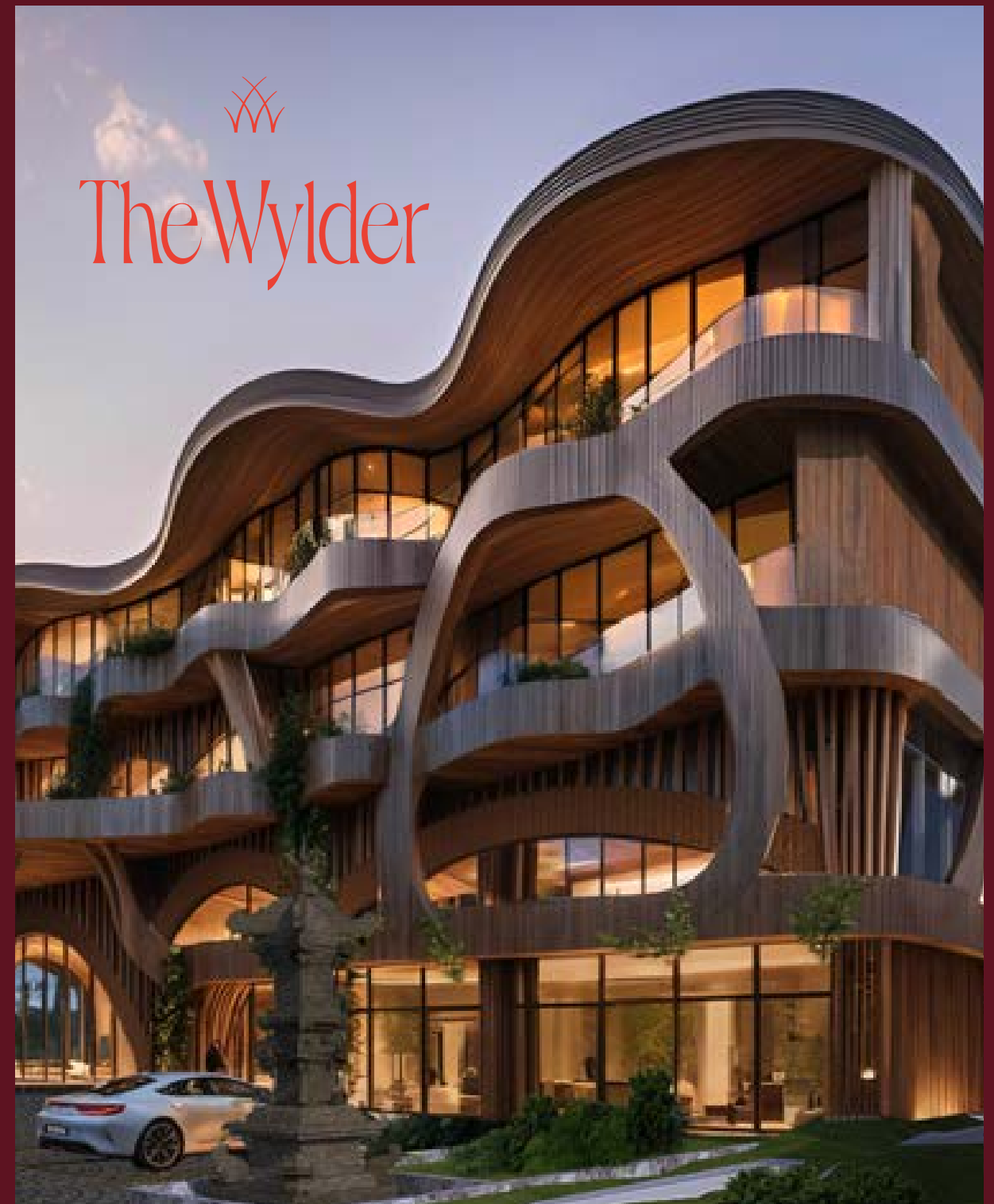

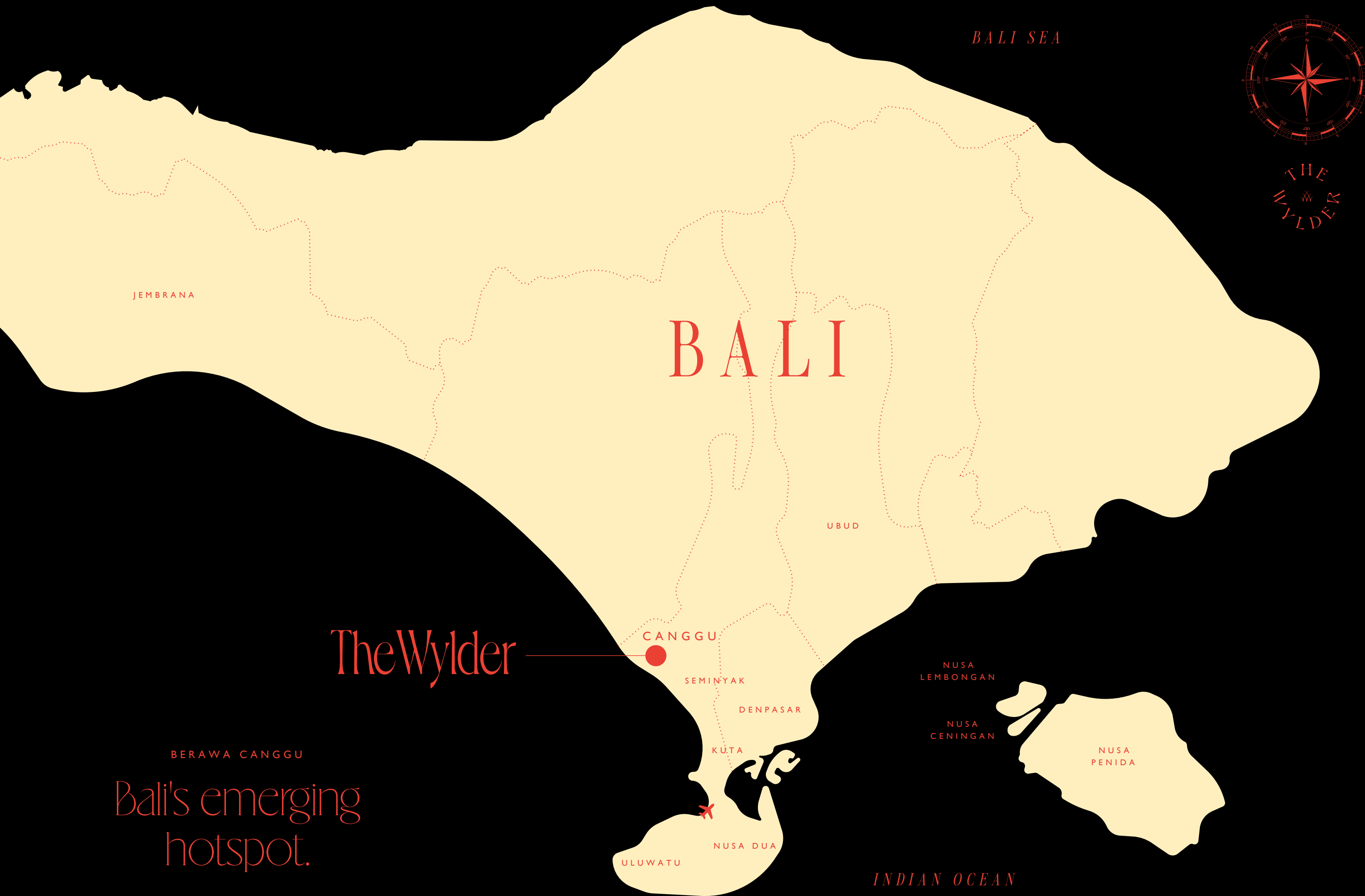
Nestled along Bali's southwest coast, Berawa has quickly transformed into one of the island's most sought-after destinations.
